

**Foster Care Agreement Between Pet Owner and the Foundation Assisting Seniors
Pet Foster Program**

This agreement made this _____ day of _____, 202__ by and between

_____ (hereinafter called "Owner"), and
Foundation Assisting Seniors Pet Foster Program (hereinafter called "Foster").

Owner is the owner of the animal described below:

Owner is unable to care for this animal; and Owner wants the Foster to hold said animal for up to thirty (30) days. In consideration of the premises and the covenants contained herein, it is agreed between the Foster and the Owner as follows:

1. Owner hereby delivers to and deposits with the Foster said animal.
2. Upon the Owner's ability to care for the animal, the Foster will return the animal to the Owner, to be carried out as soon as practicable.
3. Due to the unknown duration of care, and the need for the Foster to know when the temporary foster arrangement will be concluded, Owner agrees that the Foster will only be responsible for keeping the animal for up to thirty (30) days. If the Owner states in writing to the Foster he no longer can care for the animal, or does not desire the return of said animal, then owner relinquishes any claim, right, title or interest in said animal; and said animal becomes the property of the Foster and the Foster may exercise complete discretion as to what to do with the animal. If the Owner wishes to designate, in writing, a family member or friend to take the animal, he must do so prior to the signing of this agreement.
4. There will be no extension to the thirty (30) day period unless approved by the Foster and the Owner. This will be done on a special needs basis not a standard practice.

5. Foster agrees not to alter in any way the appearance of the animal being fostered without written permission of the Owner.
6. Foster agrees to provide adequate food, water, shelter, and humane treatment for always said animal. Foster agrees to follow all oral/and written instructions from the Owner.
7. If said animal dies or becomes accidentally injured, ill, or lost, Owner does not hold Foster responsible and releases the Foster from any claim arising from said injury. In addition, if said animal bites or injures a human or other animal, Owner will hold harmless and indemnify, and protect the Foster, from any claim or suit filed by anyone because of such accident.
8. The Foster reserves the right to seek veterinarian care without the approval of the Owner. The pet Owner acknowledges that should medical care and attention for the animal be warranted, the Owner authorizes \$_____ to be provided to cover the cost for care or register a credit card with the veterinarian to cover these costs. If care exceeds the amount allotted for care, the Foster will obtain authorization from the Owner on the animal's care and options. Should the veterinarian deem the animal's health to be so impaired that to sustain the animal would be inhumane, the Owner authorizes the Foster to euthanize the animal.
9. This Agreement is the entire agreement of the parties, and there are no oral promises or representations made in addition to this contract and it may only be changed in writing and signed by both the Owner and Foster.
